## **ACADEMIC**

By definition, an NZQA Scholarship pass places you in the top 3% of students in New Zealand. An Outstanding Scholarship pass places you in the top 0.3%. Depending on the subject, gaining a Scholarship means you are 1 of maybe 100-200 students in New Zealand to reach the top level in your subject. An Outstanding Scholarship, of which we had 7 in 2020, places you closer to the top 30. In 2020 King's was the top performer in NZQA Scholarships in Otago and Southland, in the top four in the South Island overall, in the top seven among boys' schools in New Zealand.

We had 17 individual Scholarship winners across 17 different subjects gaining 31 Scholarship passes in 2020. Not only does this reflect the calibre and work ethic of our students but also the depth of talent we have within our staff.

Acceleration is a key part of our academic programme. It enables a student to take subjects at levels beyond his chronological age bracket. To facilitate this an Individualised Education Programme (IEP) is developed for each student. The Academic Dean monitors each accelerant student, tracking his academic performance as well as his wellbeing. Outstanding student success in Cambridge (IGCSE), Scholarship and NCEA endorsement, proves the effectiveness of this programme.

# **VALUES**

A distinguishing feature of our school is our significant focus on values-based education. The focus on character and being a good man is an essential ingredient in the personal development of our students.

#### **Positive Education**

Positive Education is the science behind education at its best. It forms the foundation of how a school and its teachers can foster positive change in student learning by focusing on life-long wellbeing and strength based education. It focuses on specific skills that assist staff and students to strengthen their relationships, build positive emotions, enhance personal resilience, promote a growth mind-set and encourage a healthy lifestyle.

With the implementation of Positive Education across our school we believe we can move student well-being to a new level and equip our young men with the skills and strength to confront and conquer the many challenges they will be faced with in the future. Positive Education is nurtured effectively through the King's Men Society, Oestricher Programme and House System. These involve all boys, and Positive Education is valued highly in the everyday staff and student relationships.

#### The King's Men Society

This is a course designed to teach young men what it means and what it looks like to be a good man. The course includes students learning a diverse set of skills and taking part in a wide range of learning contexts with the aim of empowering students to leave King's High School as men who are able to succeed in the world academically, socially and culturally.

The King's Men Society programme will run throughout a student's time at King's with a record kept of their involvement.

The King's Men Society is underpinned through a philosophy of Positive Education.

### The Oestreicher (Leadership) Programme

Building leadership and capacity in our young men is crucial. The Oestreicher Programme is a school-wide, co-ordinated programme that facilitates leadership and service opportunities across a variety of contexts. Students are awarded points when they exhibit leadership traits and engage in activities designed to develop leadership. Students can attain a Gold, Silver or Bronze award each year.

#### The House System

The House system plays an integral role in the promotion of our outstanding school culture. It fosters a strong sense of community while encouraging friendly inter-house rivalry. The core school values of respect, integrity, compassion, responsibility and excellence are encouraged and reinforced as students across all year levels interact with one another in the House environment.
