PLUNKET FOUNDATION RAFFLE -

As previously conveyed via Facebook and in an email to our community, King's High School, in conjunction with the Association of Boys' Schools New Zealand (ABSNZ), is supporting the Plunket Foundation to raise funds for a new initiative to support new-born babies and their mothers. Professor Richie Poulton (Otago University) and Sir Graham Henry (Former All Blacks Coach) visited our school last term to speak to staff about a new initiative to help mothers to foster self-regulation in their babies.

To raise the required funding a nationwide raffle has been instigated. Each ticket will sell for \$10 with over \$270,000 worth of prizes to be won. The recent COVID-19 lockdown has delayed the issuing of tickets and we also had to ensure that the raffle was progressing in the same timeframe. Given the number of North Island Boys' Schools impacted, the draw for the raffle is now Wednesday 1st December. This is different to what is advertised on each ticket. Students have been issued a booklet of 5 tickets to sell. We welcome students and families to collect more booklets from the school office to sell. All tickets are required to be returned to the school office by Thursday 21st October.
