ACADEMIC

King's is placed as one of the top five boys' schools in New Zealand and one of the top two South Island secondary schools in New Zealand. In 2019 King's High School gained 52 scholarships. King's High School's success is attributed to the quality of teaching and academic programmes.

Acceleration is a key part of our academic programme. Individualised Education Programmes (IEP) are developed for each student. The Academic Dean monitors each accelerant student, tracking his academic performance as well as his wellbeing. Outstanding student success in Cambridge (IGCSE), Scholarship and NCEA endorsement proves the effectiveness of this programme.
