CLIMBING - Climbing is at Resistance Climbing Gym in Moray place (just up from Rialto). The day/time will be Saturday mornings from 8-9.30am. The cost will be \$15 per week that includes paying for a coach, entry to the gym, shoe hire and a membership to the climbing wall to allow climbing on any other days to practice/train, plus there are benefits for members like getting discounted climbing gear if that is wanted.
