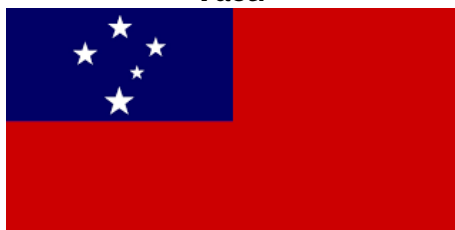

The Samoan flag, adopted in 1962, is a red field with a blue canton (upper left corner) and five white stars representing the Southern Cross. The red symbolizes courage and the struggle for independence, while blue represents freedom and the Pacific Ocean. The white stars, a key feature of the flag, represent purity.
