## Samoan Language Week 2025

**'Ia malu lou sã. Folau i lagimã – A well-grounded self, is a successful self'.**

### Phrase of the Day:

Oa mai oe? - How are you?  
Manuia fa'afetai - I am fine thanks.

### Fact:

In Samoan culture, "pe'a" refers to the male tattoo, which is a dense, extensive tattoo covering the lower body from waist to knee. "Malu" is the equivalent female tattoo, covering the leg from the upper thigh to behind the knee, but with a lighter, less dense application. Both tattoos are significant rites of passage, with the pe'a being a mark of manhood and the malu symbolizing womanhood and protection.
