**FIJIAN LANGUAGE WEEK** - "Na noqu vosa me na tekivu mai vale - My language starts from home" Word of the Day: Veivakarokorokotaki - Respecting others

<u>Facts about Fiji</u>: Traditional Fijian month names or Vula Vakaviti, are tied to ecological events like fish spawning and fruit ripening, rather than a fixed calendar. Some examples include <u>Vula i Nuqa Levu</u> (January), named for large rabbitfish; <u>Vula i Sevu</u> (February), for the first harvest; <u>Vula i Gasau</u> (April), when reeds sprout; <u>Vula i Doi</u> (May), for doi tree flowering; <u>Vula i Balolo Levu</u> (October-November), for edible sea worms; and <u>Vula i Werewere</u> (June), for land clearing for planting.

<u>Idiom of the day:</u> Turaga Vakasenitoa. (Lit.— A chief with the character of the hibiscus flower). Said of those who have the name or position of chief, but have no followers. They are like the hibiscus, which is beautiful to look at, but has no scent.
