PHYSICAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT WINTER REMINDER

Physical Education Uniform:

With the onset of winter, a gentle reminder for students and parents around the expectations for our Physical Education Uniform.

All items are to be clean and fit for use i.e. not covered in mud from sports practice or the like.

If the PE uniform is not available, then a suitable alternative should be used, accompanied with a note outlining the reason for not having the correct uniform. Note - inappropriate clothing will not be allowed to be worn e.g. tee-shirts with inappropriate prints such as alcohol, drug prints etc.

Sports shoes are highly desirable during winter activities (school shoes may be used as an alternative to gym shoes when off campus or when safety of activity dictates).

Mufti day: students are still required to wear the PE uniform - no alternative clothing is acceptable during such activities.
