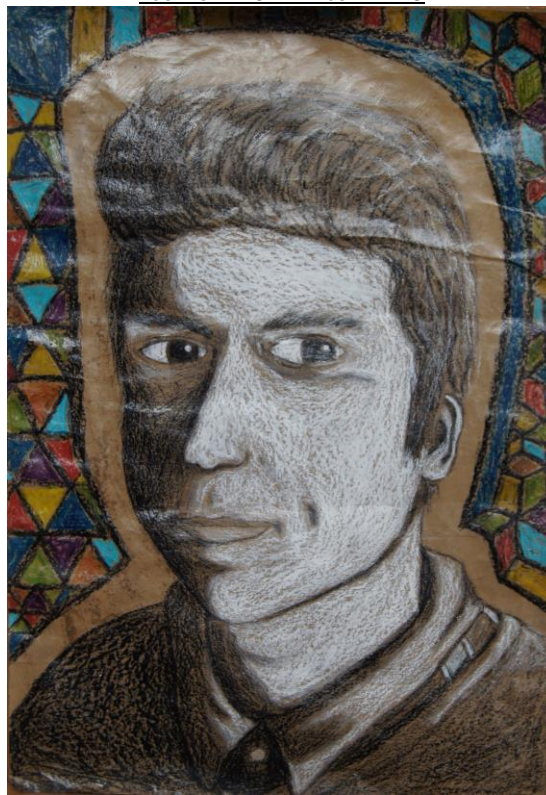
### "COOKING FOR CHANGE"
